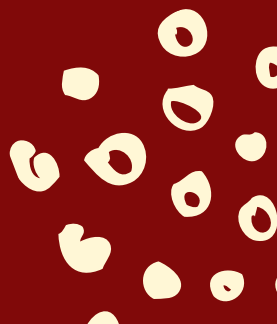

HOW TO NOMINATE

1. Refer to these guidelines and conditions of entry.
2. Nominations must include a written response addressing the question relevant to an individual or community group nomination - this must be completed to be a valid nomination to be assessed. These responses must be a maximum of 250 words long.
3. Please submit your nomination by email, post or in person, and as per instructions below:

Receipt of all nominations will be acknowledged by the Jordan Electorate Office. Please ensure you provide a correct email address with your nomination. If you do not receive a confirmation email within two business days after submitting your nomination please notify the Jordan EO via email at jordan@parliament.qld.gov.au or by telephone on 07 3447 9300.

You may be contacted after submitting a nomination and asked to provide further details.

Nominations must be received by 5 pm, Friday 29 May 2020. Late nominations will not be considered. No responsibility will be taken for nominations that are not received by the closing date.

Before progressing, the State Member will check with the nominee that they do not have objections to being nominated.
